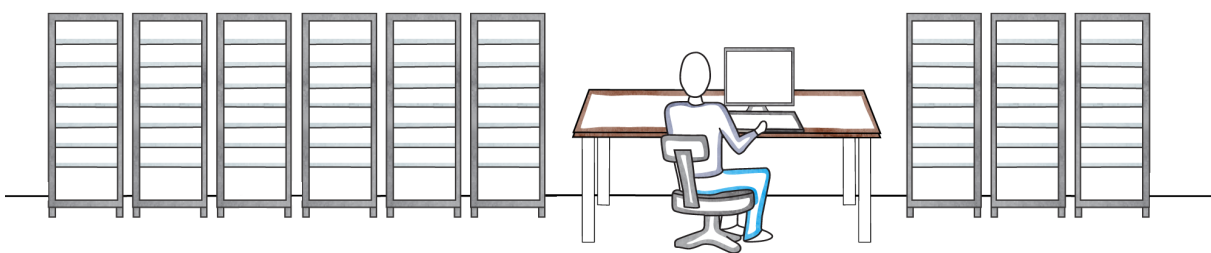
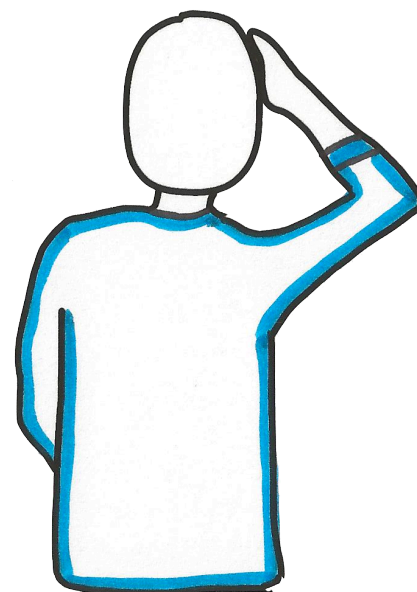
Today the IT systems that run even a modest sized organization have become incredibly specialized and complex. There is an underlying expectation that all these digital services should ‘just work.’

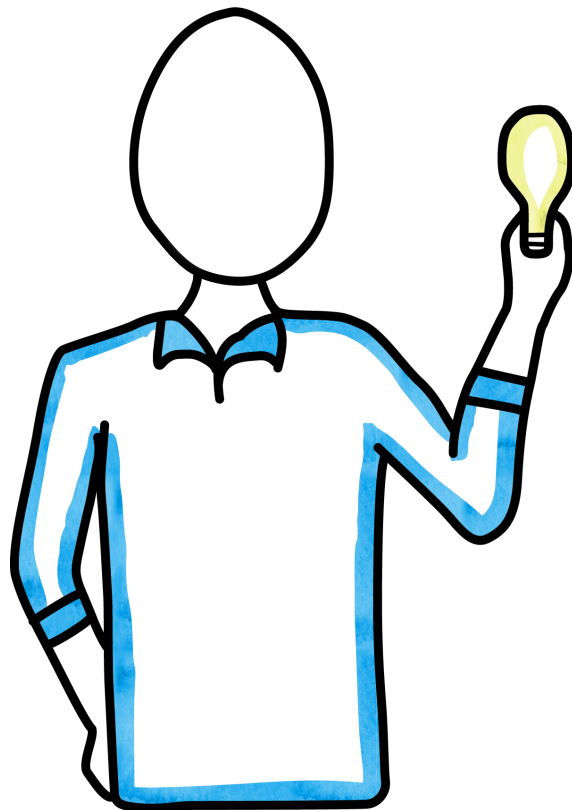

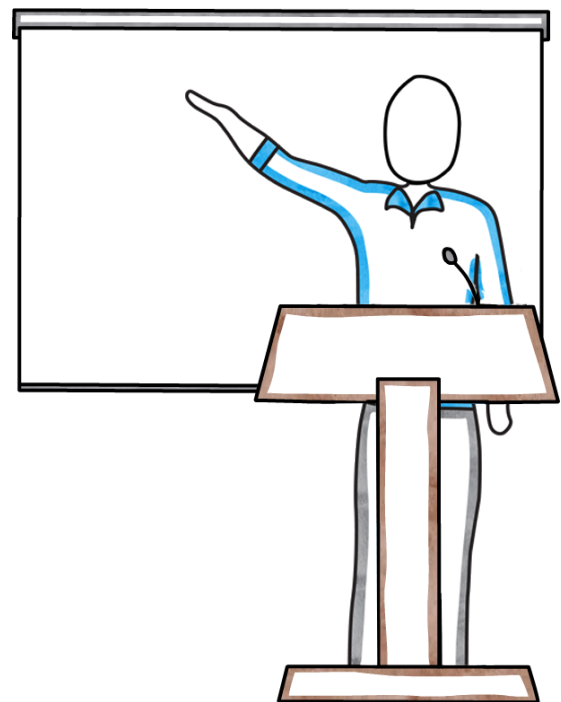

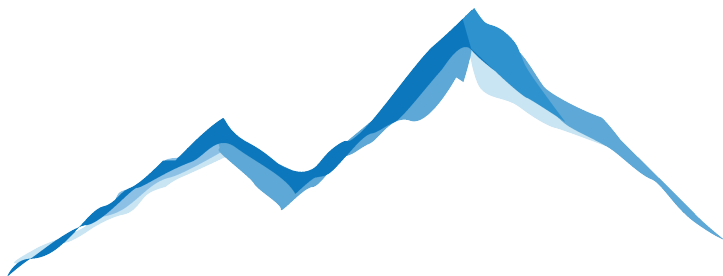
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
